

# Peonies!

- **Easy to grow, long-lived perennials.**
- **Plant in partial shade or half-day sun.**
- **Plant out from the house where they will get sufficient winter chilling.**
- **Add lots of organic material at the time of planting.**
- **Regular watering: peonies are compatible with other annual and perennial flowers on a 1 – 2 x/weekly watering schedule.**
- **Plants are tall and flowers are large, so you may wish to stake or cage them!**

32” Mid – late, fragrant. Large, very bright crimson red double with excellent form. Free flowering on strong stems. Excellent cut flower.



**Charlie’s White**

48” Very large bomb shaped, pure white flowers illuminated by a golden glow at the base of the petals. Early, fragrant, vigorous & one of the best peonies for cut flowers.



**Dancing Butterflies**

36” Single, cup-shaped, rich pink with overlapping petals & yellow stamens. Excellent cut flower.



**Edulis Superba**

32” Early, very fragrant. Very large, profuse blooms, sweet scent and a lovely rosy shade of pink.



**Immaculee**

Pure white double flowers with some yellow towards the centre. Mid-season, very fragrant.

## ***Tree peonies***



**Most peonies are “herbaceous” – their foliage dies to the ground in the winter.**

**Tree peonies are slow-growing woody shrubs that reach 3 – 4’ over many years.**

**Add plenty of organic material.**

**These plants are grafted. Plant with graft union at least 1 – 2 inches *below* soil. This is one of the rare times we recommend deep planting.**
