

## Sweet Million

Hybrid Indeterminate

One of the few VFN cherry types. Produces hundreds of fruit, similar to Sweet 100.

## Valencia

Heirloom Indeterminate

Attractive orange fruit of moderate size. Tough skin resists weather damage.

## Special selections

### Amish Paste

Heirloom Indeterminate

Very large (12 oz) fruit is meaty, for slicing, sauce, and drying.

### Better Bush

Hybrid Indeterminate

Compact variant of Better Boy, if you're limited for space. VFF2NAsT

### Champion Bush

Hybrid Determinate

Compact variant of Champion, if you're limited for space.

### Gardener's Delight

Hybrid Indeterminate

A very productive, reliable regular cherry-type.

### Husky Gold

Hybrid Indeterminate

Very compact plant with 6 oz golden fruit. VF

### Oregon Spring

Hybrid Determinate

Interesting early-fruiting variety is nearly seedless. Bred for coastal and rainy areas, but does well here.

## Patio

Hybrid Determinate

Very dwarf plant to 1 - 2' produces a dozen or more 3 - 4 oz fruit. Great for containers!

## Red Currant

Heirloom Indeterminate

Wild South American species with tiny, sweet-tart fruit that are intensely flavored. Massively productive.

## Roma VF

Hybrid Determinate

Still a favorite for heavy yields of plum-shaped, meaty fruit on very compact plants that don't need staking.

## Stupice

Hybrid Indeterminate

Czech variety (say "stoo-peach-uh") with loads of 6 - 8 oz fruit on a compact plant.

## Yellow Stuffer

Heirloom Indeterminate

Golden, hollow, firm-skinned fruit looks like a bell pepper! Very unusual.

# Tomatoes



## Best bets

### Ace

Hybrid                      Determinate

Compact plants with large, attractive fruit. Low acid; great for salads. VF55

### Better Boy

Hybrid                      Indeterminate

Very productive plant with loads of firm, medium-sized fruit. VFN

### Black Krim

Heirloom                      Indeterminate

Purplish skin and flesh. Good yields.

### Celebrity

Hybrid                      Semideterminate

Reliable producer, large fruit; relatively compact plant to 6' or so. Good disease resistance. VFFNT

### Champion

Hybrid                      Indeterminate

Robust plant to 8' or more! Heavy yields. First fruit that sets is very large; then lots of medium size ones. VFNT

### Costoluto Genovese

Heirloom                      Indeterminate

Beautiful, ribbed and fluted fruit is very large and mostly meat. Excellent flavor; good yields. A favorite!

### Early Girl

Hybrid                      Indeterminate

The best all-purpose hybrid tomato. Reliable production, 8 - 10 oz. fruit, excellent flavor. VFF

### Giant Belgium

Heirloom                      Indeterminate

Gigantic fruit, 1 - 2 lbs each. Fruit is pink-red when ripe.

### Juliet

Hybrid                      Indeterminate

Phenomenal yields of small plum-shaped fruit that can be used fresh, or in cooking. A favorite!

### Lemon Boy

Hybrid                      Indeterminate

Bright yellow fruit has excellent sweet flavor. Good yields of 6 - 8 oz. fruit.

### Mortgage Lifter

Heirloom                      Indeterminate

Big plant, heavy yields of medium-sized, meaty, pink fruit for sauce, canning, freezing.

### Shady Lady

Hybrid                      Determinate

Outstanding new variety! Very compact plant yields loads of large, attractive, flavorful fruit. VF

### Sungold

Hybrid                      Indeterminate

Rapidly becoming one of the all-time favorite varieties. Super-sweet, but tangy, and very heavy yields.

### Whopper

Hybrid                      Indeterminate

A reliable large-fruited tomato for this area. Good flavor, fruit over 1#, good yields. aka Park's Whopper

## Great choices

### Carmello

Hybrid                      Indeterminate

French variety with large, thin-skinned fruit, excellent flavor.

### Caspian Pink

Heirloom                      Indeterminate

Large pink, meaty fruit similar to Beefsteak but more reliable here.

### Cherokee Purple

Heirloom                      Indeterminate

Traditional variety with purple-pink fruit that is juicy and flavorful.

### Garden Peach

Heirloom                      Indeterminate

Small fruit is blushed pink and fuzzy! Spicy, distinctive flavor.

### Golden Jubilee

Hybrid                      Indeterminate

Well-known variety with golden-orange fruit. Mild, low-acid, sweet. Productive, dependable. (= Yellow Jubilee)

### Green Zebra

Heirloom                      Indeterminate

Medium-size fruit is striped yellow and green! Sweet, mild, but good acid balance.

### Jelly Bean

Hybrid                      Indeterminate

Another ridiculously productive, extra-sweet, grape-sized tomato.

### Mr. Stripey

Heirloom                      Indeterminate

Very large fruit is striped red, gold, and pink. Extra-high sugar content.

### Pineapple

Heirloom                      Indeterminate

Golden orange fruit is tangy like a pineapple.

### Sweet 100

Hybrid                      Indeterminate

The original tiny-fruited extra-sweet cherry type. Large clusters, very productive.
